Town and Country Planning (Schemes of Delegation and Local Review Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 2008

Notice of Review: Planning Application 14/01905/APP – Provide 17 Outdoor Stalls and 5 Indoor Stalls for Weekly (Sunday) Car Boot Sale at Transition Town Forres, Bogton Road, Forres

At the meeting of the Moray Local Review Body (MLRB) on 27 August 2015, the MLRB agreed to defer consideration of the above case to seek Transport Scotland's view on the substance of new evidence regarding comments by the Applicant that a Left In/Left Out junction arrangement would be acceptable to Transport Scotland and seeking preferred wording for a planning condition to deal with the junction provision if agreeable.
