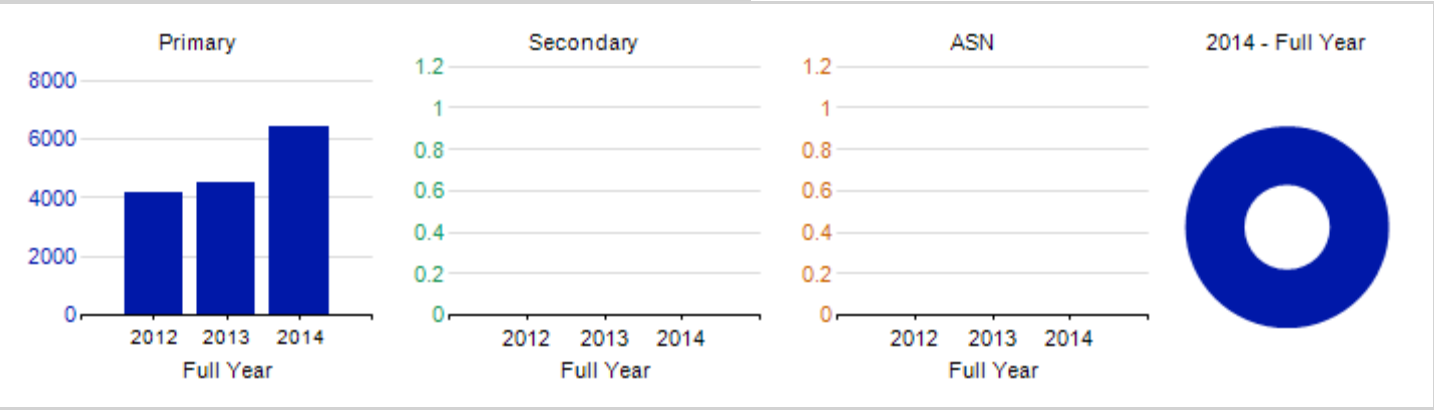

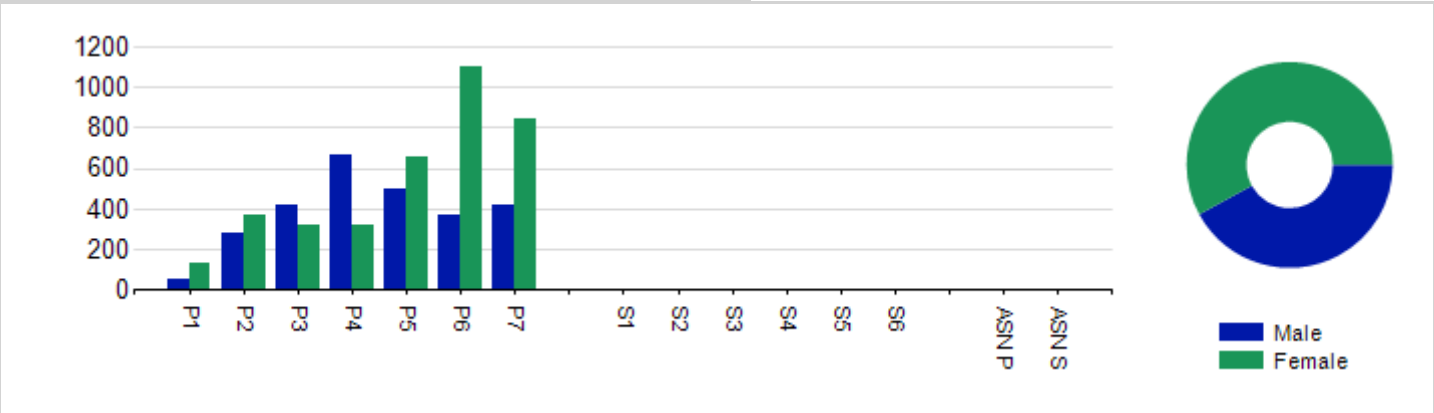

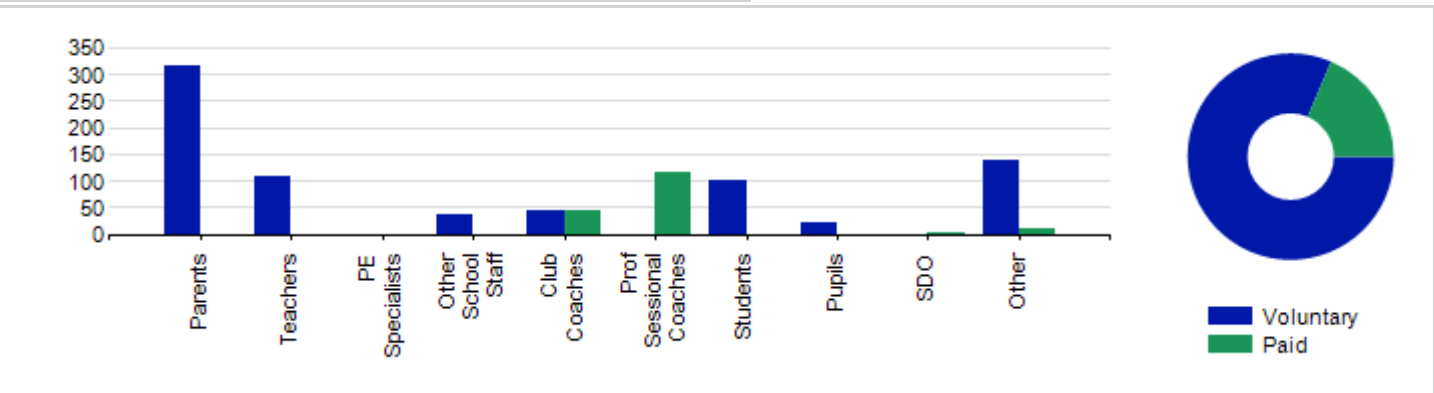
Single School: Participant Sessions4 by School Type



Single School: Participant Sessions4 by Year Group & Gender

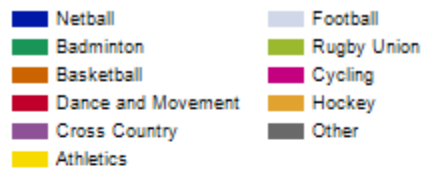


Single School: Deliverer Sessions5 by Type and Paid/Voluntary

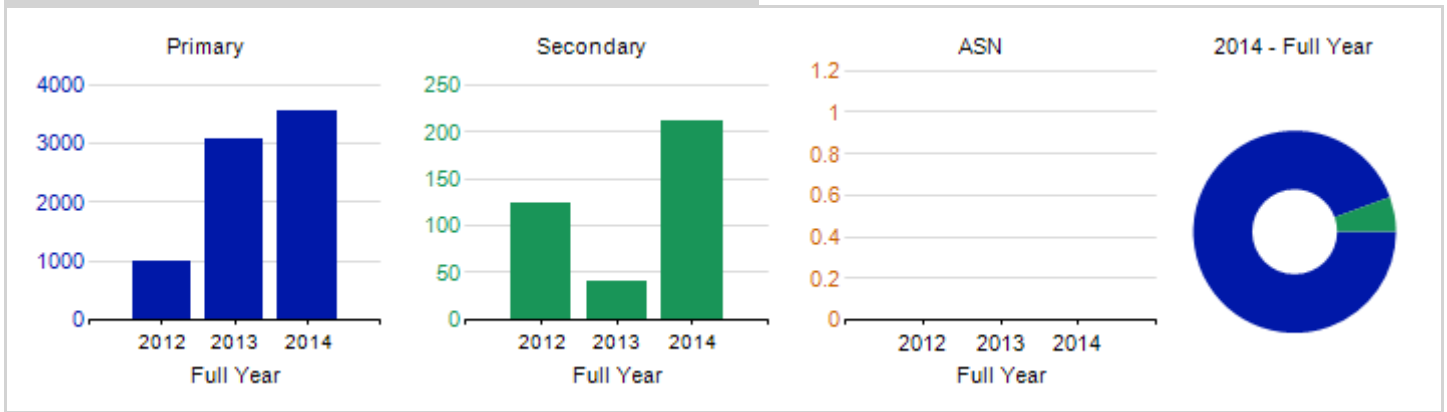

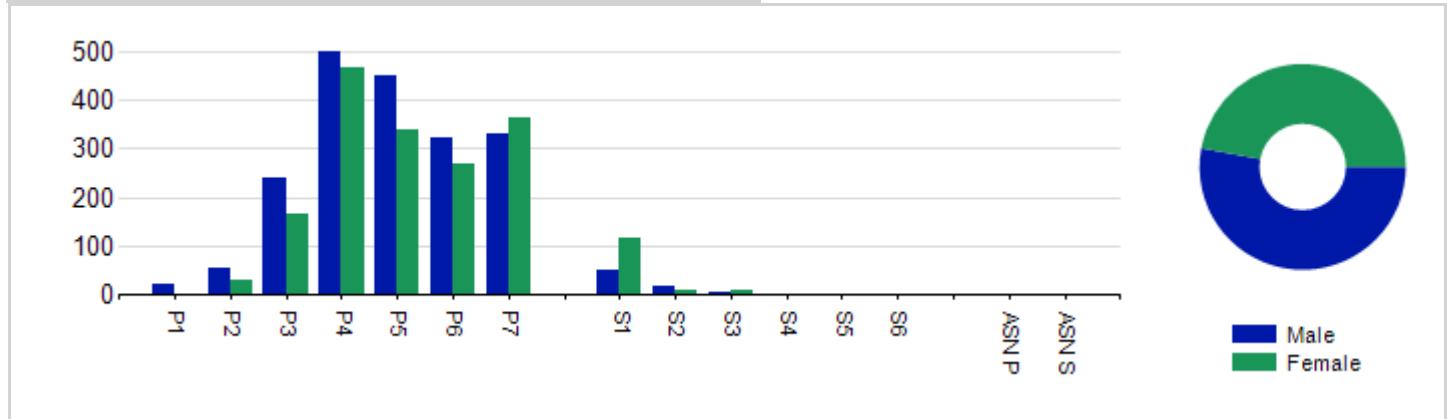

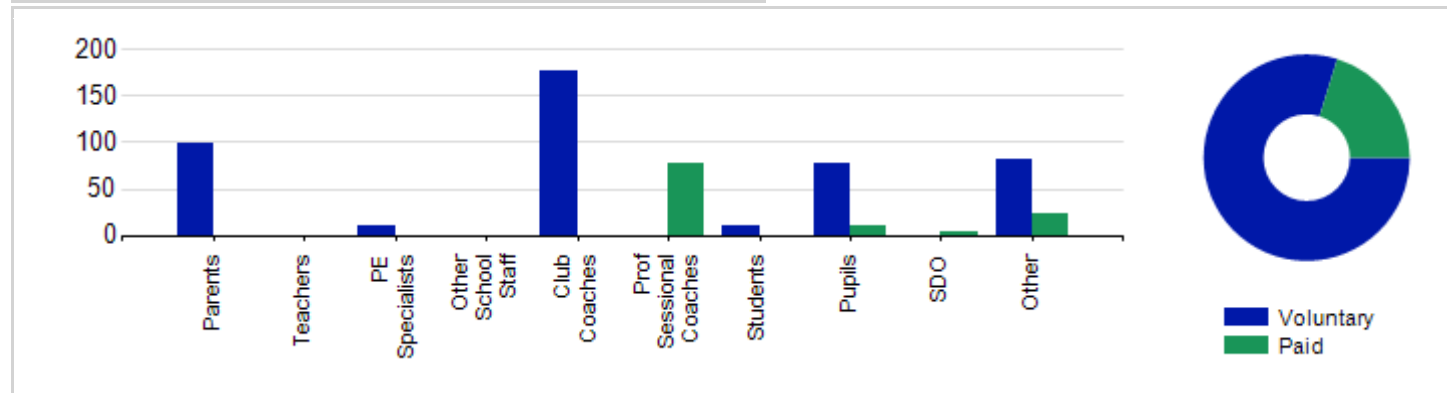
**Multi School: Participant Sessions<sup>4</sup> by School Type**



**Multi School: Participant Sessions<sup>4</sup> by Year Group & Gender**

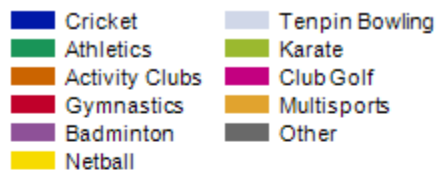


**Multi School: Deliverer Sessions<sup>5</sup> by Type and Paid/Voluntary**
