










### Single School: Deliverer Sessions5 by Type and Paid/Voluntary

1. Activities are recorded in ASMO as 'Activity Session Blocks' which describe a group who meet to Badminton take part in an activity. Fitness Football Rugby Union If a block involves pupils from several different schools, this is called a multiple school activity. The Fit For Girls Basketball multiple school data shows the total amount of activity at multiple school sessions. Each school Dance and Movement Other only consumes a portion of this activity. If a multiple school activity includes more than one coordinator's schools, the activity will show up in both coordinators reports. This will lead to multiple counting if we add up the multiple school activity reported under all the coordinators. 2. Distinct participants are pupils who have attended at least one session of Active Schools supported activity across the selected year/term (whether this was in a single or multiple school activity). 3. The Average Activity Sessions/Block figure shows the average length of a block (i.e. how many weeks did the average block run for?) 4. Participant Sessions are the 'visits' pupils have made to activities. These figures do not represent the distinct pupils, and should only be taken as indicative of participation. 5. Deliverer Sessions are the 'visits' deliverers have made to activities. These figures do not represent the distinct deliverers, and should only be taken as indicative of delivery. Distinct deliverer information is only available at the local authority level. 6. Figures with N/A are not available for the 2008-11 phase of Active Schools. Charts which refer to information pre 2011 will show a huge increase from 0 - this is because we cannot include any 2008-2011 data at this level.











#### Multi School: Deliverer Sessions5 by Type and Paid/Voluntary
