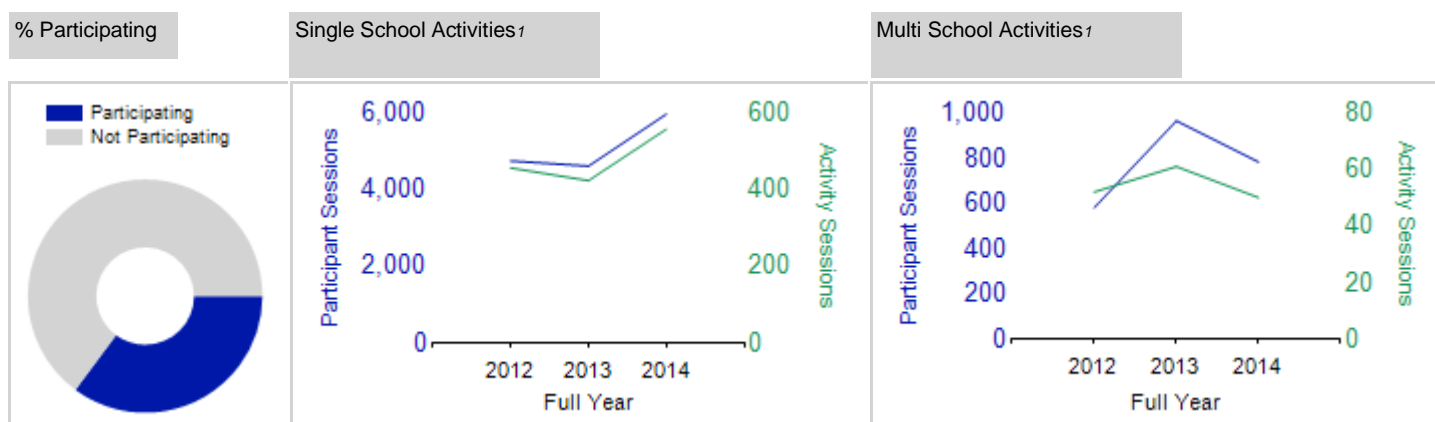

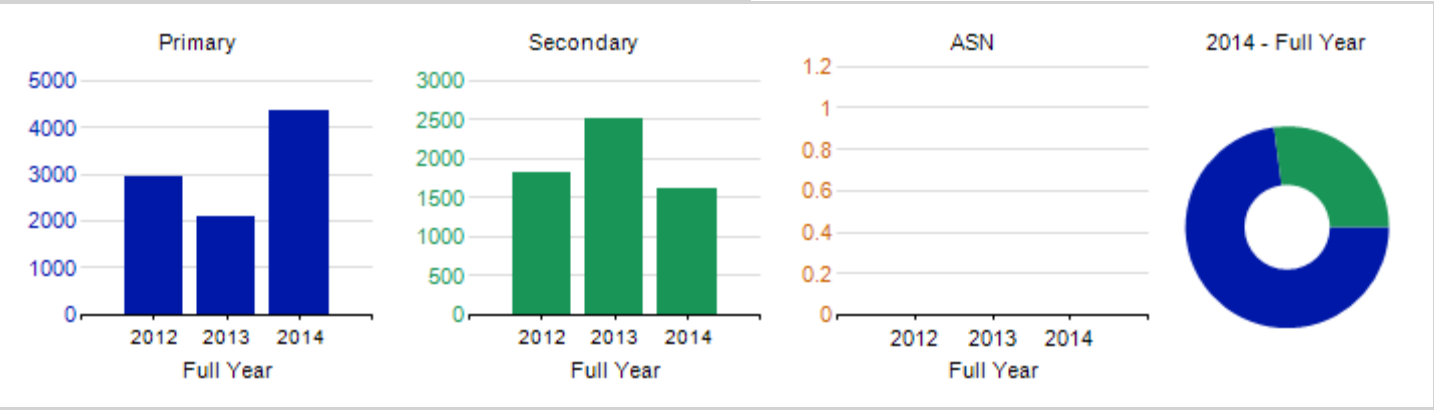

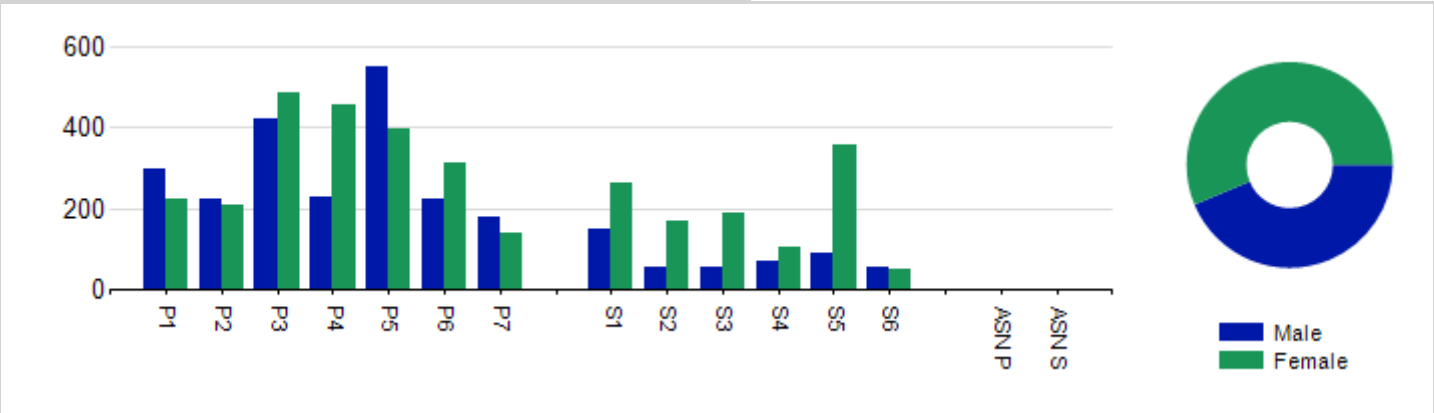

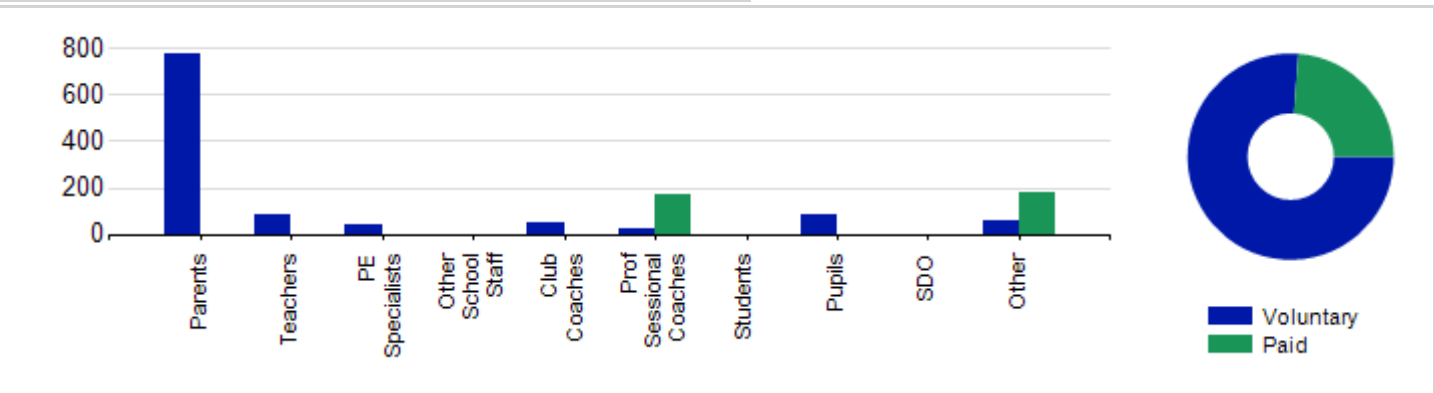
Single School: Participant Sessions4 by School Type

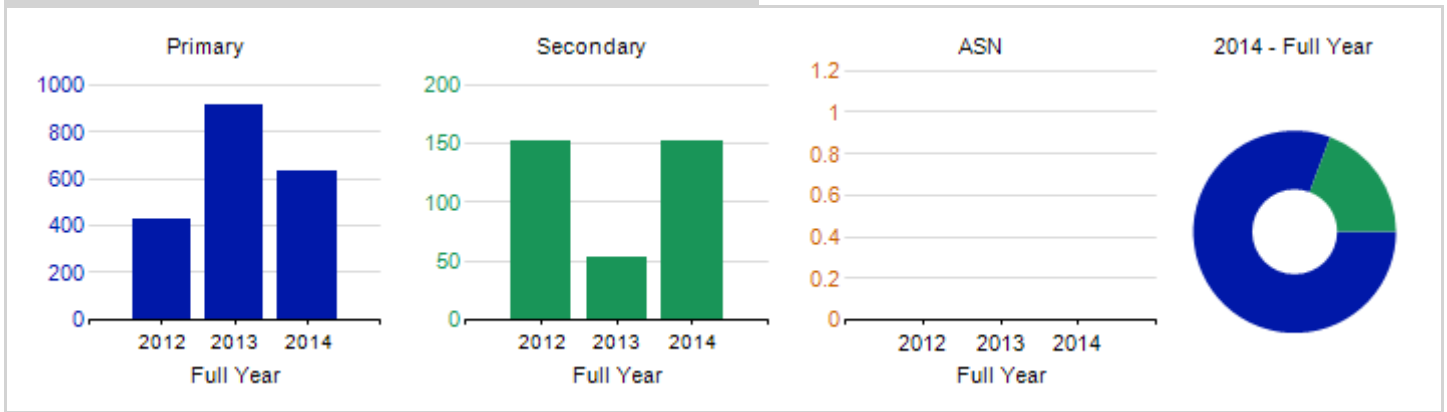

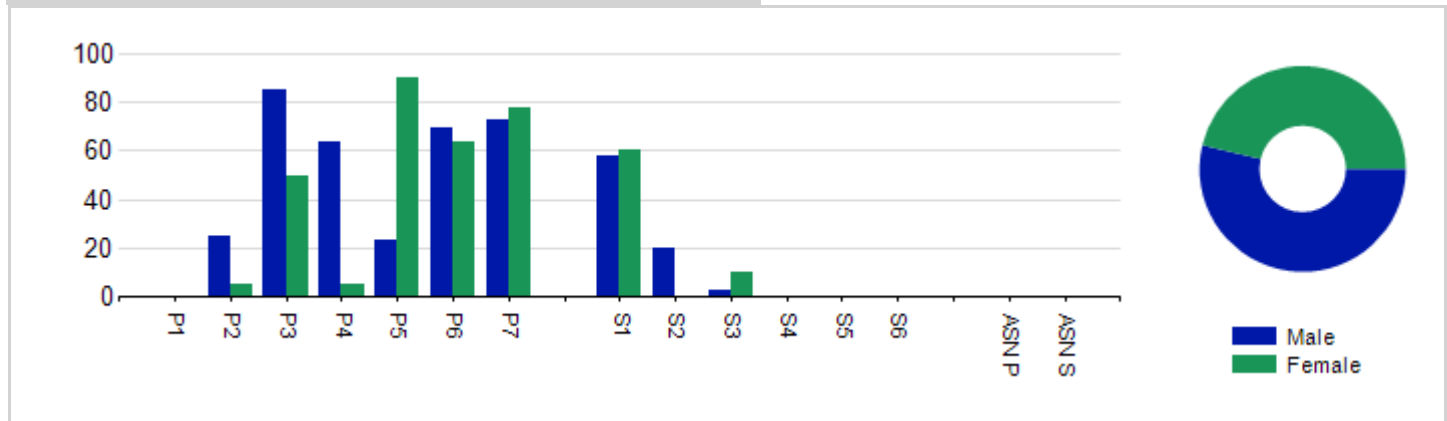

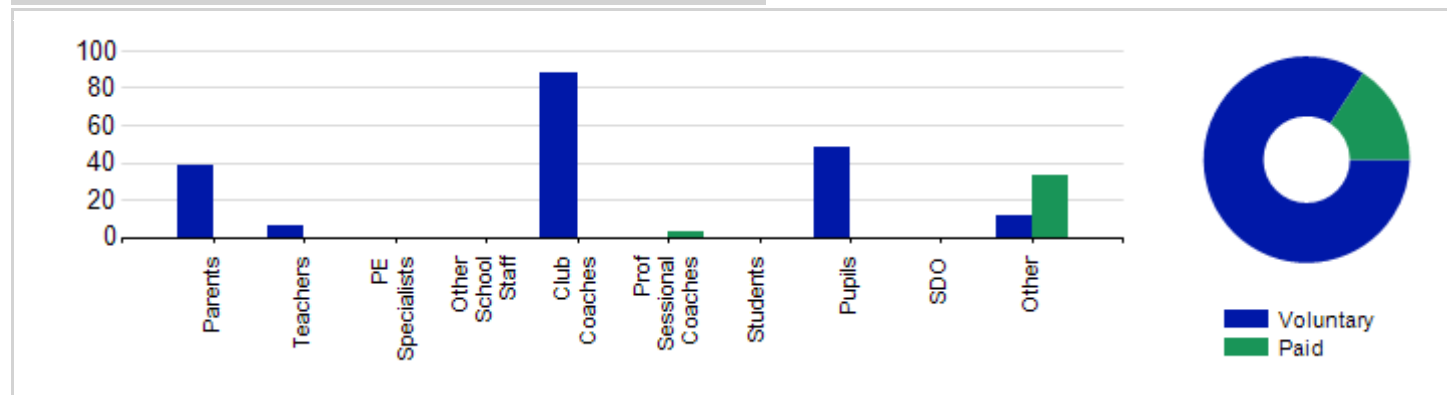
Multi School: Participant Sessions⁴ by School Type



Multi School: Participant Sessions⁴ by Year Group & Gender

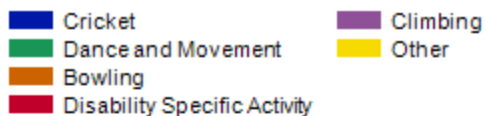


Multi School: Deliverer Sessions⁵ by Type and Paid/Voluntary
