!!IMPORTANT UPDATE!!

<u>Final draft guidance</u> on the GIRFEC parts of the Children and Young People's (Scotland) Act 2014 is now available on the Scottish Government website.

273 sleeps to GIRFEC live! The pace of implementation in terms of the GIRFEC aspects of Children and Young People's (Scotland) Act 2014 is picking up and January will see the development of guidance, Named Person Service training, a Moray Child's Plan and Integrated Pathway for support. Training and learning sessions will also be in place through the year to support this. Information will be published here.

Looked After Children and Young People Strategy built on the principles of GIRFEC, reaffirms the commitment to improve outcomes for looked after children and lays out our vision for the future. Launched in November.

<u>Looked After Children Data Strategy</u> sets out the strategic direction for developing data on looked after children over the next five years. See also government news release.

Touchpoints for Third Sector- Touchpoints are checklists to help Third Sector organisations prepare for parts 4,5 and 18 of the Children and Young People (Scotland) Act 2014.

Information sharing- Updated version of the Pan Grampian Practitioners Guide to Information
Sharing. Page 6 has been update to reflect that the Health Visitor will be the Named Person from birth until the child's first day at school.

Remember, you don't need consent to Share Information if you have a concern about a child or young person's wellbeing. Please refer to page 17 of the guide above for more information.
