#### Common Core Skills and the Named Person

The Common Core describes the skills, knowledge, understanding, and values that everyone should have if they work with children, young people and their families, whether they are paid or unpaid.

The skills, knowledge and understanding are described as "essential characteristics" and are set out in two contexts; relationships with children, young people and families and relationships between workers. They are also explicitly cross-referenced to the guiding principles of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). The values are taken from the Getting It Right For Every Child approach and will be at the heart of any training regarding Named Person training.

Convention on the Rights of the Child. The minimum expectations children and families should have of those who support them. Cross-referenced to the guiding principles of UNCRC and GIRFEC Values.
