GETTING IT RIGHT FOR EVERY CHILD

Named Person Service in Moray is live and operational. All children from 0-18 now have an allocated Named Person. If you are a Named Person or Lead Professional, or may be in the future, please ensure you have attended the appropriate training and have accessed the new paper work which can be found on the GIRFEC webpage. Any queries contact Susan Stronach or Jenny Price.

Accessing Services – All services should now be using Section A and Section B of the Child's Plan to enable professionals to refer into them. If it doesn't work for your service please contact Susan Stronach or Jenny Price to discuss further. The new paper work can be amended to make sure it meets everyone's needs. Please DO NOT create your own paper work.
