- 7. Applications for new postal votes and amendments or cancellations of existing absent voting arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5pm on Tuesday 23 May 2017.
- 8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017.
- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address **by 5pm on Thursday 8 June 2017**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017.
