

### **Description**

Level development sites with services available in the adjoining access road. This site would suit development for a wide variety of uses including light industrial, warehousing and distribution uses. The property is available on a long ground lease basis for the purposes of commercial development.

#### **ERDF Funding and Tenant Restrictions**

Provision of this serviced land has been part funded by the European Regional Development Fund to assist small to medium sized enterprises. Applications to lease will therefore only be considered from small to medium sized enterprises which are defined as enterprises with less than 250 employees and which have an annual turnover of less than 50 million euros or which has a balance sheet asset of less than 43 million euros, and has no more than 25% of its capital or voting rights owned by a larger firm or public body.

#### Rent

Offer over £7,000 per annum exclusive of Vat and rates are sought.

#### **Lease Terms**

Period 99 years.

#### **Rent Review**

Rent to be reviewed 5 yearly to the current market value of the site or to a percentage of the development value of the site.

#### **Permitted Use**

A wide range of uses will be considered although its anticipated usage would include light industrial, warehousing and distribution.
