The Trusts & Foundations market is getting more crowded how will you stand out from all the other good causes? In this workshop, you will find out the secrets of writing a winning proposal - covering everything from more practical tips to creative storytelling tools.

WORKSHOP 1 (AFTERNOON SESSION) -

DANA SEGAL - RAISING MONEY ONLINE

Looking to maximise your online giving? This workshop will cover the nuts and bolts of successful online fundraising - using a wide range of case studies, it will help you to understand how, using behavioural insight, you can create a simple and effective online giving process.

WORKSHOP 2-

Moray LEADER is investing in Moray's future by funding projects that will strengthen the local economy and build capacity in our local communities.
