### THE DIRECT DEBIT GUARANTEE



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Moray Council will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Moray Council to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Moray Council or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Moray Council asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

Instalment Plans Available

Instalments can be collected:



Monthly until January or March, on these dates 1st or 5th or 15th or 25th

Weekly on a Friday

### Fortnightly on a Thursday

**Quarterly** over four dates 30th May

30th November 28th February

**Half-Yearly** over two dates 30th May

**Annually** on one date 30th June

Your Direct Debit payments will be collected on the date stated, except when the date falls on a weekend or a bank holiday, when they will be collected on the next available banking day.
