#### **Cultural Quarter**

Visitor Orientation Centre inc "Speyside Whisky Experience"; private 4/5 star 100 bed hotel; multi-purpose theatre and performance space at Elgin Town Hall; enhanced public space at Cooper Park and Lossie Green

#### **Early Years STEM**

This is about delivering flexible in and outdoors learning spaces for children aged 3-8 and their parents to grow interest in science and break down cultural norms when they are starting to form - linked to early years nursery roll out

#### **Manufacturing and Innovation Centre**

This is a local hub where manufacturers can get hands on experience to demonstrations and support about the way that modern technology can help to improve manufacturing processes

- Heads of Terms agreement with details of the projects involved


















