4. Despite the above statistics, in this authority we do not have a regular rough sleeping community. These figures are self-reported by our applicants and officers suspect that some applicants may state that they have slept rough when they were actually staying with friends/relatives.

We are a relatively small authority and rough sleepers are often identified and reported quite quickly to our department. When we are made aware of anyone rough sleeping, we will take a proactive approach and visit applicants at the reported location. We will offer some form of accommodation where appropriate.

We are currently unaware of anyone who is rough sleeping on a regular basis within our area.
