4) Spynie Application 20/00781/APP

The Spynie Hospital Area planning application was discussed.

Traffic is a known issue on Duffus Road. Parking threatens to impede traffic flow at times. We note that the Local Development Plan includes junction improvements at Morriston Road and North Street Bishopmill.

Flooding is a concern and is not sufficiently addressed in the application. The concerns raised by the Moray Flood Prevention Team must be addressed to their satisfaction and the FPT must be allowed to act fully independently.

Contaminated land must also be resolved to the independent satisfaction of the relevant team.

Overlooking has been raised by members of the community and is a common concern so must be addressed sympathetically.

In our response to the Local Plan we raised a concern aboput the loss of NHS estate and the future of health provision locations in Elgin particularly as it is growing massively with Elgin South and Findrassie as well as this application site.

We are also interested in the integration of affordable housing and social housing with other types tenure.
