A	<p>Awarded where it has been established by health professionals that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the person can no longer remain in their current home; and</li> <li>• there is a critical and urgent need for the person to move to accommodation which will support them to carry out essential daily living activities or will help with the provision of essential health and social care needed to carry out daily living activities.</li> </ul>	<b>500</b>
B	<p>Awarded where</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the person is long term and substantially disabled and this is likely to increase whilst living their current home; and</li> <li>• it has been established by health professionals that the person cannot safely access and use facilities in their home needed to carry out essential activities of daily living.</li> </ul>	<b>350</b>
C	<p>Awarded where it has been established by a health professional that a change of property would significantly increase the person's level of safety, ability and independence when completing essential activities of daily living.</p>	<b>150</b>
D	<p>Awarded where it has been established by a health professional that a change of property would moderately increase the person's level of safety, ability and independence when completing essential activities of daily living.</p>	<b>50</b>
E	<p>No points will be awarded where there are no recognised barriers in place for a person to carry out their day to day activities.</p> <p>No points will be awarded where Moray Council can provide alternative solutions to the reported difficulty in completing essential activities of daily living (e.g. aids and adaptations).</p>	<b>0</b>
