Around 114,000 premises across Scotland will benefit from access to faster broadband.

→ R100 contracts

Around 114,000 premises across the North, Central and South of Scotland are expected to benefit from the contracts delivered by Openreach.

→ Commercial coverage

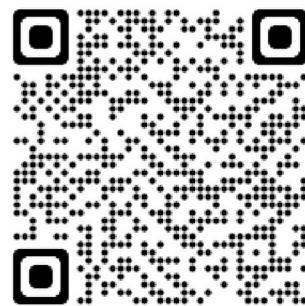
Ongoing build by commercial operators across Scotland.

→ Voucher scheme

The R100 Scottish Broadband Voucher Scheme offers a subsidy of up to £5,000 for all eligible premises. Individual vouchers can also be pooled into a project with neighbours.

The Scottish Government is investing over £600m in the Reaching 100% (R100) programme to ensure that every home and business in Scotland can access superfast broadband.

R100 Scottish Broadband Voucher Scheme

Could your home or business be eligible for the R100 Scottish Broadband Voucher Scheme (SBVS)?

→ Eligibility

If your property is sub-30Mbps and it's not due to receive access to a superfast connection through the R100 contracts or a commercial provider, it may be eligible for a voucher.

→ Find a supplier

There are over 40 registered suppliers on the scheme. If they can connect your property, they'll talk you through the technologies available and apply for a voucher on your behalf.

→ Up to £5,000

A voucher worth up to £5,000 could help your home or business secure a superfast connection.

Available solutions may depend upon your location and supplier, but could include:



Fibre to the premises (FTTP)



Fixed wireless access broadband

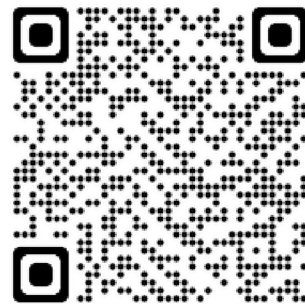


Satellite broadband

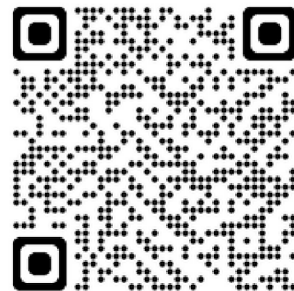
