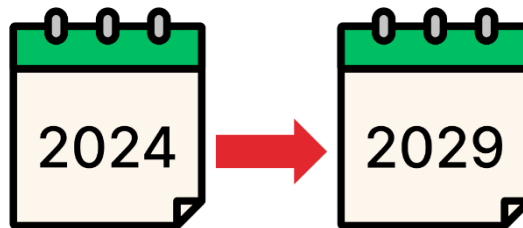

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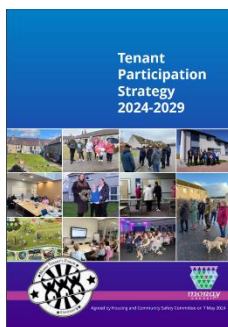
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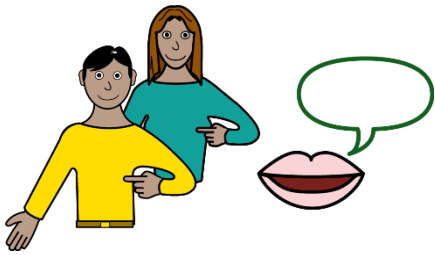


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Introduction



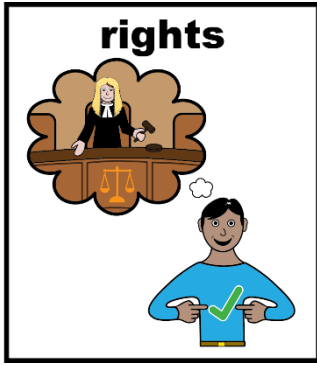
Tenant Participation is having a say in the decisions that affect your home and community.



By law, **social landlords** must involve their tenants in decisions about their housing services.



A **social landlord** is an organisation who provides housing at an affordable rent. Moray Council is a **social landlord**.



We must:

- Treat you fairly and with respect.
- Make it easy for you to talk to us and get the information you need.
- Make it easy for you to take part in and be involved in decisions about housing services.




An organisation called the Scottish Housing Regulator checks how we are doing. These checks include tenant participation.





The Scottish Housing Regulator is sometimes known as the SHR.

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<p>things to do</p> 	<p>Our strategy has 3 important things that we will do.</p>
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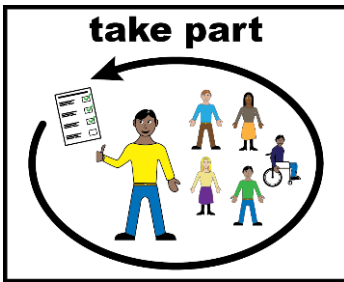
These are our 3 important things.

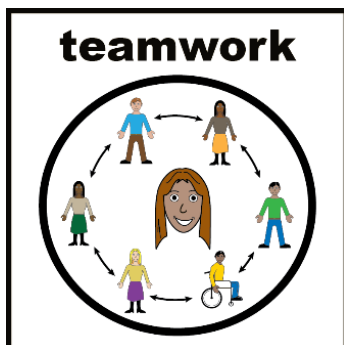
1. Give people the chance to tell us what they think about our housing services.

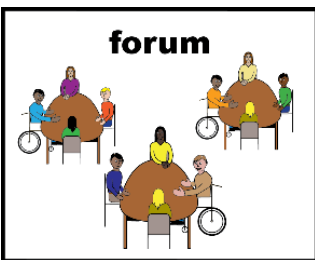
What you tell us will help us to know what we are doing well and what we can do better.
