1. **Chair Neil Kidd welcomed the attendees and opened the meeting at 19:00hrs**

2. **Apologies were received from:** Callum Stuart, Cllr T. Colyer, and Phil Eckford.

3. **Police Matters:** Sgt Allen gave an update on matters in Keith;

There have been instances where groups of youths have been travelling into Keith by bus on Friday and Saturday evenings and congregating outside the TESCO store and then moving on to Seafield park. Police officers are monitoring the groups when they gather and taking the necessary action when required.

There have been issues with illegal drugs being posted to addresses in Keith via Royal Mail, investigations are ongoing.

There was one special service call to assist Paramedics with an elderly lady who had a fall in her home. Two home fire safety visits were also carried out.
