Consultation on polling district and place arrangements in Moray

The current arrangement of Moray polling places and the districts they serve requires to be reviewed in accordance with the law and some changes may be proposed.

The Council must ensure that all electors have reasonable facilities for voting and that arrangements are as realistic as possible. We must also make sure that, as far as is reasonable and practicable, the polling places are accessible to all electors.
