Matters Arising: Update on Vattenfall Windfarm

Once we get the feedback from the other Community Councils, a copy will be sent to the committee about what update is to be planned and for

the Chairman to approve. Vattenfall have not received any

communication as yet, telling them it has been turned down. This was

discussed.
