Adult Confidence Sessions
1:1 Better Biking sessions to improve your cycling skills and confidence. Suitable for all from beginner to regular cyclist

Adult Led Rides / Family led rides
Local led rides in small groups at a sociable pace

E-Bike Try-outs and free Bike Loans
An introduction to e-bikes with the chance to try different styles and loan bikes for active travel.

E-bike fleet loans and cargo bike loans
Bike loans to organisations to encourage staff to utilise active travel.
Cargo bikes available to loan to local businesses for van-free delivering!

Maintenance Classes & Dr Bike sessions
1: Basic care, cleaning and puncture repair

What can we offer to businesses?

Fleet Loans – free of charge

- We can provide you with a fleet of e-bikes for your staff to use for commuting to work.
- Loans can be anywhere from 1 month to 3 months, and sometimes longer if required.
- This can increase productivity, reduce emissions and lead to a happier, healthier workforce!



What can we offer to businesses?

Cargo bike hire

- We can provide you with an electric cargo bike for a free loan.
- Loans can be anywhere from 1 month to 3 months, and sometimes longer if required.
- Cargo bikes can replace diesel vehicles for the delivery of smaller items. Bikes can typically hold 50kg in cargo and can be configured to hold dogs/children and goods!

What can we offer to businesses?

Cycling confidence sessions

- Our development officer can support staff by offering one-to-one and/or group support to staff who need a confidence boost to ride a bike to work, and by showcasing local active travel routes.
- We could organise workplace events, such as led rides or 'Dr Bike' sessions.



What can we offer to businesses?

Advice and training

- We can provide bespoke basic bike maintenance sessions at your location so that staff can perform basic repairs on their bikes.
- We can advise individuals on what type of e-bike to purchase, and how employers can sign up for Cycle To Work schemes.
- We can signpost employers to gain accreditation in the 'Cycle Friendly Employer' scheme, offered by Cycling Scotland. This can lead to funding for infrastructure such as secure bicycle storage at your workplace.
