


### Q3 Are you an employee of Moray Council?


# Q4 Are you a parent or carer who has a child/children attending preschool, primary or secondary?

# Q5 Which setting/s does your child or children attend? (Select all that apply)






# Q7 Does your child/ren receive additional support with their learning within school?


# Q8 Which of the following supports are in place for your child/ren? (Select all that apply)







# Q19 In answering question 17, are your responses in relation to a large Primary (more than 100) or small Primary (less than 100) school?




# Q20 In your opinion what should be the minimum utilisation in a Primary school building?






# Q26 In your opinion, how long is a maximum acceptable one-way travel time for primary aged pupils?

# Q27 In your opinion, how long is a maximum acceptable one-way travel time for secondary aged pupils?




