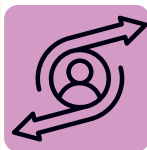

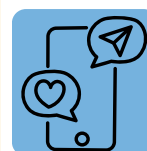

# MAFAN BREW AND BLETHER

at Lossiemouth High School

Moray's Armed Forces Advocate Network met at Lossiemouth High School on Wednesday 10 June. Thank you to Amy at Lossiemouth High School of hosting the Brew & Blether.

The agenda for the day included discussions regarding various resources aimed at supporting Armed Forces pupils in schools within Moray.

One of the resources discussed was Forces Children Scotland's story "Max's Big Move". "Max's Big Move" is a story co-created with children from Armed Forces Families, particularly pupils from Leuchars Primary School, to reflect real experiences of moving, leaving familiar environments, and adjusting to new settings

The Dandelion Project has also been working on an Armed Forces Friendly Standard to roll out to schools in the new academic session.



A draft version of the Standard was discussed, and feedback was provided for any activities on a checklist to be clarified or amended. It is hoped that the Armed Forces Friendly Standard provides assurance for Armed Forces families that schools comprehend the unique challenges of military life and are prepared to provide appropriate support.

Hannah was appreciative for all of the discussion and feedback and is looking forward to the next Brew & Blether event in September in the next academic session.



# SHARING GOOD PRACTICE

Meeting at 3SCOTS, Inverness



Hannah was kindly invited to 3SCOTS Welfare Centre on Wednesday 3 June to give an overview of the Dandelion Project and the work the Project aims to achieve.

The meeting was facilitated by Lou Kinnear from MLG Highland, with whom Hannah collaborates closely. Lou shares invaluable knowledge with Hannah, and helps with networking, so Hannah was delighted to present at this meeting. Colleagues around the table also heard from Jane from Help for Heroes and what her role as a Community Builder entails.

Additionally, the meeting's agenda included a presentation on an impressive new resource created by pupils at Drakies Primary School. The book, titled "Welcome to the Highlands," offers insights into life in the Highlands, particularly for newcomers to the area. Pupils from the school attended the meeting to explain the book to the adults present while also providing an opportunity for everyone to listen to it being read aloud. This initiative showcases remarkable work by the pupils. Well done to all involved.

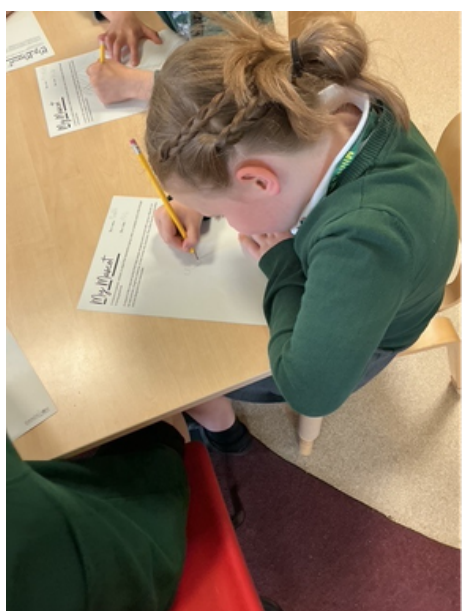
# DANDELION PROJECT OUT IN SCHOOLS

## Milne's Primary School



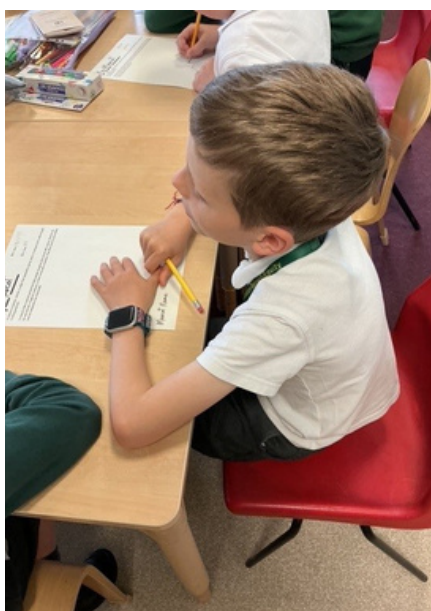
Pupils at Milne Primary School took part in a session learning about the Commonwealth Games, which will be held this year in Glasgow. As part of this discussion, the pupils learnt about the official mascot this year associated with the Games, named Finnie.

They linked this learning and the idea of the mascot to the Dandelion Project Bear. They made the connection that the Bear is the Project's mascot.



The purpose of a mascot is to serve as a person, object, or animal that embodies and symbolises the identity of a particular group. We discussed the creation of a unique mascot that would represent Armed Forces children, reflecting the distinct experiences and identities of the individuals within this community.

The group engaged in a discussion about their preferences, including favourite animals, foods, and hobbies. This exchange of ideas inspired the design of their mascots, resulting in several intriguing designs!

## P7 Transition to Lossiemouth High School



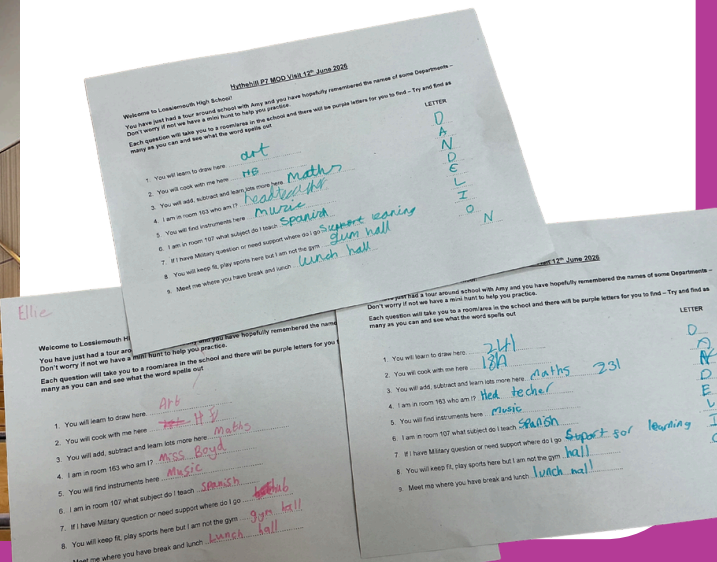
On Friday 12 June, the Primary 7 pupils from Hythehill Primary School participated in a transition activity afternoon at Lossiemouth High School, guided by Amy and her senior pupils. All participating pupils had connections to the Armed Forces. Hannah from the Dandelion Project accompanied Mrs. Maxwell and the Hythehill Primary pupils during their short walk to the high school and throughout the afternoon's activities.

The pupils arrived at Lossiemouth High School and were given a guided tour of the school. On Friday afternoon, the school was quiet, as all secondary pupils had already left for the day. During the tour, the P7 pupils familiarised themselves with the various departments and had the opportunity to meet some of the teachers they may see again in their first year.

Following the tour, the pupils were divided into groups of three for a scavenger hunt around the building, which was lots of fun!



The children were given maps of each floor of the school and questions to try and solve which would then reveal a word at the end!

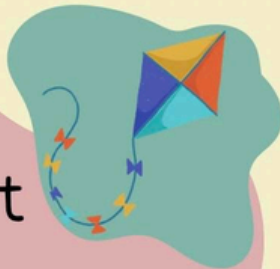
