This Trust has charitable status and is registered with the Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator (OSCR) – number SC019017.

Purpose of Trust

Under the Moray and Nairn Educational Trust Scheme 1935, The Moray Council has the power to make grants to persons who have been resident in Moray and Nairn for five years and to organisations belonging to the former Counties of Moray.

Types of grant and who can apply

Bursaries for attendance at a Scottish University or central Institution. Grants for Adult Education within Moray and Nairn Provision and maintenance of sports facilities for the benefit of children and young persons resident in Moray and Nairn. Travel grants for purposes of an educational nature. Any person or project that meets the criteria.

The closing date for applications is 30th September each year.

Grants are means tested, the upper limit of household earnings is £34,000. Applicants must have been resident in Moray and Nairn for the past 5 years.

Available Funds

Total funds £676,791.

The amount available to disburse in the financial year 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022 is £14,702.
