

Hedge

Proposed species;

70% Hawthorn

20% Hazel

10% Romanns/Dog Rose

Spacing; Double row with 30cm gap and 25cm spacing between shrub (Approx 6 shrubs per LM)

When to plant; Bare root - Best September but any time upto May

Cell grown - Between June and October.

Planting Height: approx. 20/40cm



Spacing; Advise grouping in random groups of 3-4 with larger choice to back (can thin out as maturing) with a spacing of approx. 700mm centre to any other centre. Groups should be planted approx. every 5m centre to centre along the boundary.
