

Note: As of December 2002 'proportion of unemployment' replaced 'unemployment rate'. The proportion of unemployment is a percentage of working age residents who are claimants in an area rather than the previous rate which was based on the percentage of the economically active population.

# **RECENT TRENDS**

Over the last month, unemployment in:



Moray has risen from 1,099 to 1,111, an increase of 1.1%



 Scotland has fallen from 114,409, to 110,722, a decrease of 3.2%



UK has fallen from 1,243,434 to 1,196,269 a decrease of 3.8%

Over the past 12 months, unemployment in:



 Moray has fallen from 1,421 to 1,111, a decrease of 21.8%



 Scotland has fallen from 142,965 to 110,722, a decrease of 22.6%



 UK has fallen from 1,584,468 to 1,196,269, a decrease of 24.5%

### **PROSPECTS**



There is usually a decrease in Moray's unemployment total between March and April.



Between 2004 and 2013, the average March - April monthly decrease was 89.



It is possible, therefore, that Moray's unemployment total could fall next month.

# **AGE AND DURATION**

Between February and March (data rounded to nearest 5):

- Long term unemployment (52weeks+) has fallen from 225 to 215
- Youth unemployment (24 years and under) has risen from 300 to 310
