

RECENT TRENDS

Over the last month, unemployment in:



Moray has risen from 1,072 to 999, a decrease of 6.8%



Scotland has fallen from 105,397, to 101,107, a decrease of 4.1%



UK has fallen from 1,142,340 to 1,089,976 a decrease of 4.6%

Over the past 12 months, unemployment in:



Moray has fallen from 1,285 to 999, a decrease of 22.3%



- Scotland has fallen from 134,410 to 101,107, a decrease of 24.8%
- UK has fallen from 1,495,758 to 1,089,976, a decrease of 27.1%

PROSPECTS



There is usually a decrease in Moray's unemployment total between May and June.



Between 2004 and 2013, the average May - June monthly decrease was 33.

It is possible, therefore, that Moray's unemployment total could fall next month.

AGE AND DURATION

Between April and May (data rounded to nearest 5):

- Long term unemployment (52weeks+)
 has fallen from 210 to 200
- Youth unemployment (24 years and under) has fallen from 280 to 260
