

### **UNEMPLOYMENT TRENDS**



<u>Note:</u> As of December 2002 'proportion of unemployment' replaced 'unemployment rate'. The proportion of unemployment is a percentage of working age residents who are claimants in an area rather than the previous rate which was based on the percentage of the economically active population.

#### **RECENT TRENDS**

Over the last month, unemployment in:



Moray has fallen from 932 to 912, a decrease of 2.1%



Scotland has fallen from 97,075, to 96,971, a decrease of 0.1%



UK has fallen from 1,020,290 to 995,835 a decrease of 2.4%

Over the past 12 months, unemployment in:

- Moray has fallen from 1,220 to 912, a decrease of 25.2%



- Scotland has fallen from 132,716 to 96,971, a decrease of 26.9%
- UK has fallen from 1,418,674 to 995,835, a decrease of 29.8%

#### PROSPECTS



There is usually a decrease in Moray's unemployment total between July and August.



Between 2004 and 2013, the average July - August monthly decrease was 18.



It is possible, therefore, that Moray's unemployment total could fall next month.

## AGE AND DURATION

Between June and July (data rounded to nearest 5):

- Long term unemployment (52weeks+)
  has fallen from 195 to 190
- Youth unemployment (24 years and under) has risen from 245 to 260
