The Moray Council Service

With a locally based specialised fleet of vehicles Moray Council offer a reliable, practical and cost effective commercial waste service. This flexible VAT free service can be adapted to meet individual business needs.

The service allows businesses to recycle a wide variety of materials including paper and cardboard, tins and cans, plastics and glass bottles and jars, as well as collection services for non-recyclable waste.

Businesses can select from a range of waste and recycling containers from plastic sacks, 140 Unlike some other waste contractors, Moray Council does not offer a co-mingled recycling collection service. This is because the quality of recyclable materials collected in this way can sometimes fail to meet the high quality standards required to ensure materials can be reprocessed and recycled into new products.

Further support and advice is available from dedicated Waste Officers.

Existing customers of Moray Council's Commercial Waste and Recycling Service will receive a printed copy of this guide, whilst other businesses and new customers can download a copy from the Council's website.

Commercial recycling customers also receive an entry pass to use the Council's Recycling Centres free of charge for certain recyclable items.
