Welcome to the December 2014 edition of our Newsletter.

It is the time of year when people tend to look back and reflect on the year gone by. I have been looking at what we have achieved over the last 12 months, within the Shared Lives Service in Moray.

Reflection.....

It has certainly been a very busy and exciting year for the Moray Shared Lives Service. We have recently appointed 2.5 new support staff. The extra office staff will allow more time for the promotion, growth and support of the service, carers and the people who access support from us. 2015 should continue to see the expansion of the service as a whole.

Natalie Falconer started this month. She joins the office support team with Social Care qualifications and a background in working with people who have learning disabilities. We hope she will enjoy her new role as Shared Lives Community Care Assistant and that she will be an asset to our Support Team. We will still be based at the Moray Council Annexe in Elgin, though Natalie will also spend some time each week out in our other offices, to get to know the referring teams.

The other 2 staff are due to start in January, Details will follow in the next edition of the newsletter.

We have welcomed 5 new carers to the team recently. That takes the total number of Shared Lives Carers up to 11. We are also currently assessing another 4 throughout Moray. We have a panel set for this month, to decide if they will also join the carer team. Carefully recruiting more carers, will allow us to offer a wider range of both day support and respite provision throughout Moray. We are adding to our range of individual carer service leaflets. They will give information on each new service that becomes available. They will be added to the Shared Live Section of www.moray.gov.uk or you can request them in paper format, if you do not have internet access, via the Shared Lives Support Team. Throughout the year, our carer team have increased the activities, outings and support we are able to offer. Through training, experience and recruitment, we now have a wider range of knowledge and experience throughout the carer and admin support teams e.g. increased knowledge to help us support people with dementia and carers who have worked with a range of people who have a variety of learning disabilities. This will allow us to continue the excellent work we have become known for as well as offering Shared Lives to more people. This year we have begun to work closely with our learning disability team throughout Moray and will continue this piece of work into the New Year.

Part way through this year, we were no longer able to offer the small amount of overnight respite, as we did previously. From feedback and requests, I know this provision has really been missed. Hilary, our carer, provided an excellent service, but unfortunately her circumstances changed. I am pleased to report that we should have 3 carers from the New Year, who are able to offer overnight respite/short breaks. As the carer team grows further, we hope to extend this part of our service even further. We will be looking to streamline our referral process in the New Year. Meantime, please continue to contact us by phone or email, as detailed above.

Karys Paterson, near Spey Bay: Karys has no paid care experience but she has recently completed her full carer training programme. Karys has personal experience of supporting a family member with dementia and is keen to use her life experience to help others. She has considerable transferable skills from her past employment, especially with regard to communicating effectively with people from all walks of life. Karys has moved in with her sister and her family. Her sister, Hilary Williamson (who is one of our established carers), and Karys intend to offer a day support together. Taster visit times are available for booking now.
