Continue to provide Smoking Advice Service	NHSG priority	NHSG	08/09		New SAS advisor joined team in January – the post was vacant between October 07 and January 08. To date 285 clients seen in community (2008), plus number of clients in Dr Grays clinic on a one-to-one basis. 111 were non-smokers at 4-week follow-up – approx 39%. Allowing for DNA rate of 21% raises this to 50%. The workplace advisor continues to provide services to companies in Moray and we will be looking to adopt the		Tracey Gervaise

				requirements of the Health Promoting Health Service (CEL) in the forthcoming year. Secondary care and Workplace advisors will work closely together on this development. The SAS will now also be covering Speyside, previously covered by community nursing staff. The pharmacy scheme remains a popular means of accessing the service. The launch, in August 2008, of the new pharmacy contract has meant that all pharmacies will now be required to offer cessation support. This will increase the number of options across Grampian and there is a requirement for pharmacies to collect the 4-week data as part of the contract. A number of new initiatives are being piloted in the SAS at present. We are currently trialling SMS appointment reminders and have recently introduced telephone followups. We hope both will increase attendance rates, motivation and, ultimately, data return at the 4-week follow up point. We will shortly be introducing a new referral pathway for pre-operative smoking cessation. Clients will be seen within the Secondary Care arm of the service and the proposal has been well received by Consultants and GPs.
